

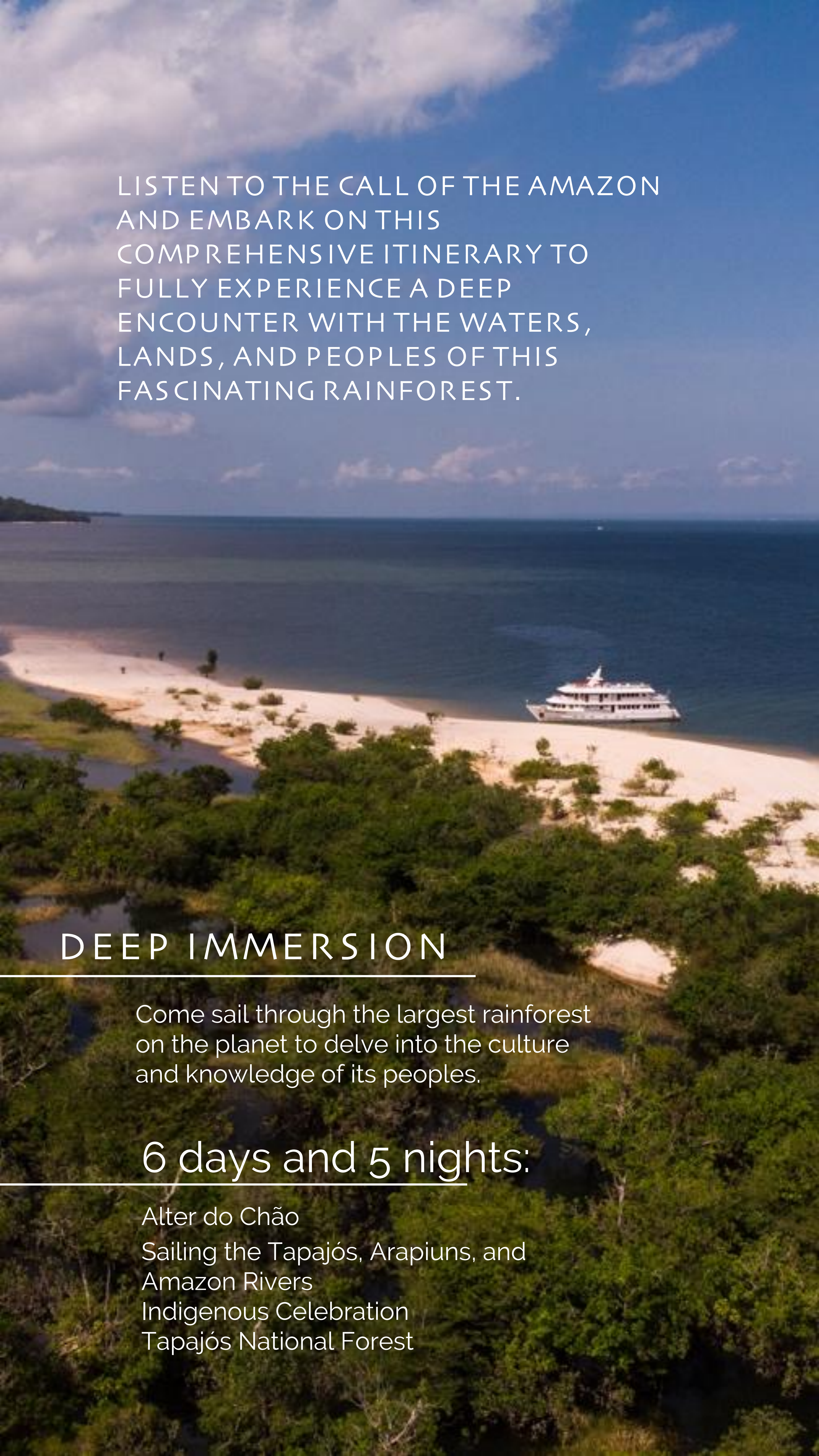

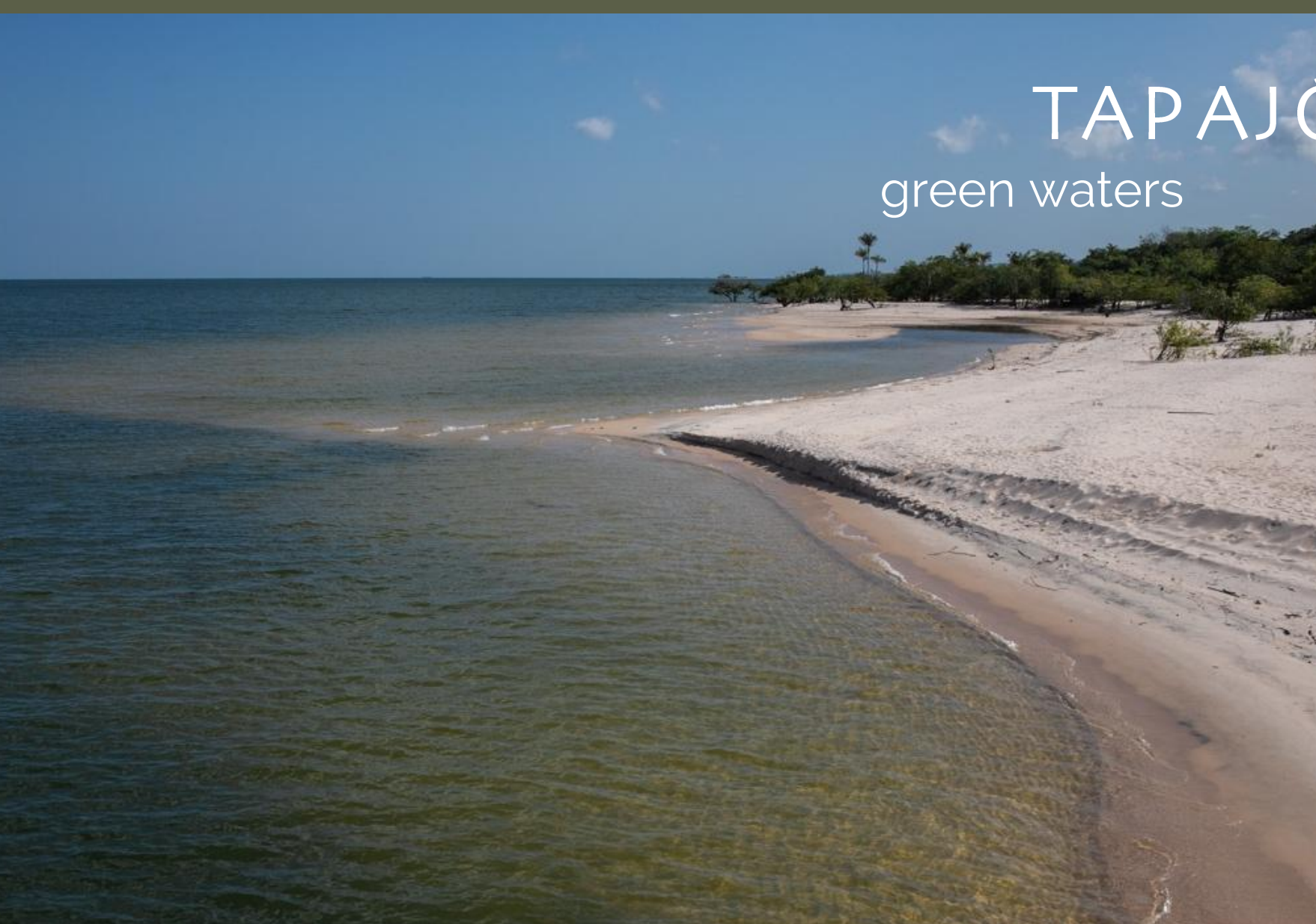

A TRIP THROUGH THREE RIVER ECOSYSTEMS IN THE LARGEST BIODIVERSITY HOTSPOT ON THE PLANET.

You will navigate three different river ecosystems in one trip. Each river has a different shade of water and wildlife, influencing the cultures and traditions of riverside communities.



TAPAJÓS RIVER

green waters

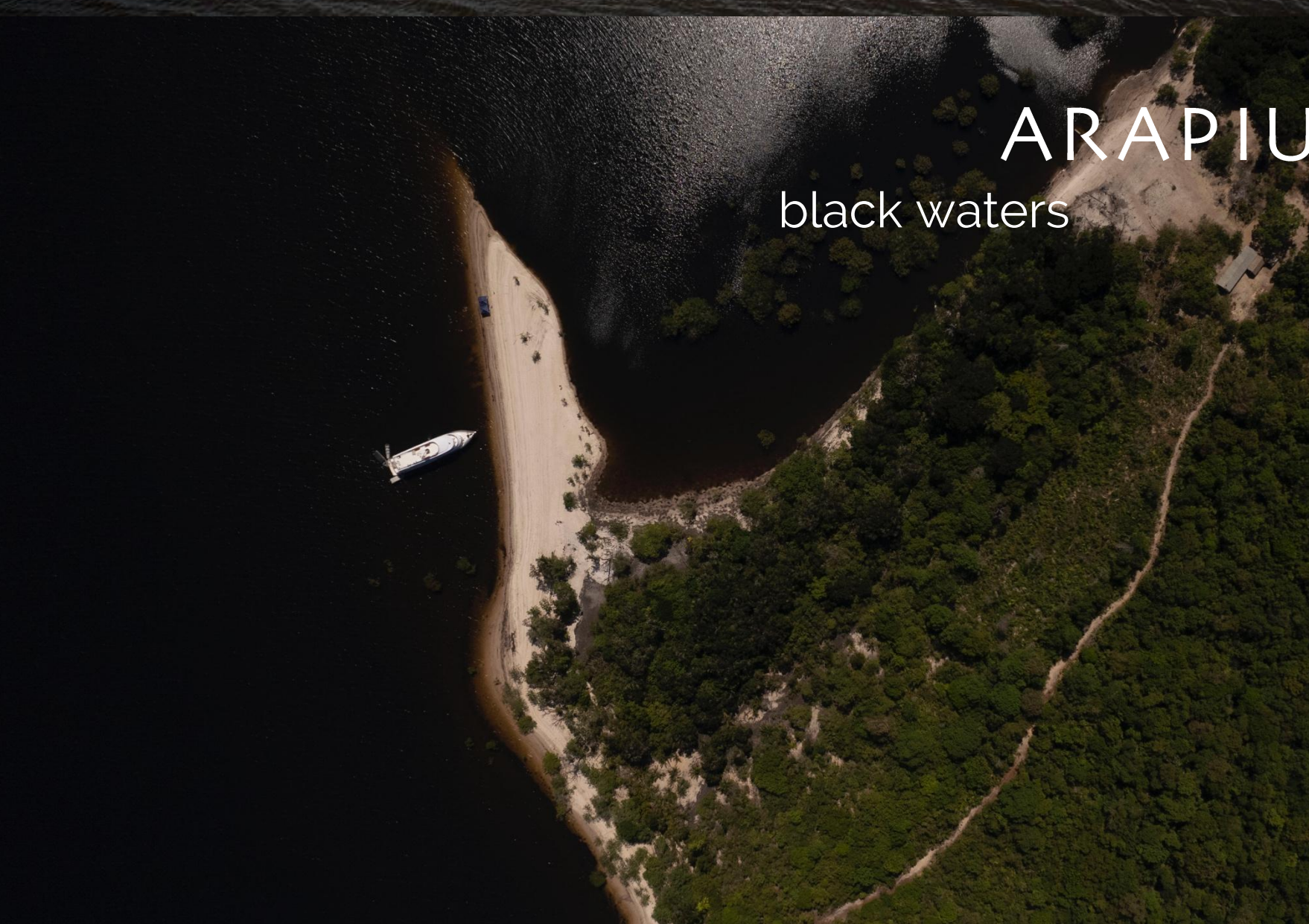
The vastness of the famous clear green river makes us forget that we are sailing in fresh waters. With one of the rarest shades of water in the Amazon, we feel like we are at sea surrounded by rainforest.



AMAZON RIVER

white waters

To feel the power of one of the world's most famous and voluminous rivers flowing into the ocean, we will sail through a narrow channel in this ecosystem. The “white” waters of the Amazon River, as its brownish waters are called, are rich in nutrients. The ideal habitat for much of the Amazonian fauna, where we can spot a wide variety of birds and fish for piranhas.

The fascinating blackwater river has many stories to tell about the communities that have learned to respect its cycles for centuries and now teach us how all natural species can live in harmony.

DAY BY DAY - DEEP IMMERSION

ARRIVAL IN ALTER DO CHÃO

The nearest airport is Santarém (STM), which is about a 30-minute drive away. Alter do Chão will be the starting point for our boat trip.

DAY 1

BOARDING TAPAJÓS BEACH AND NIGHT CANOEING

Starting at 12 PM, we will embark passengers coming from Alter do Chão and Santarém.

To welcome you to the meeting of the forest with the immensity of waters, we will make a stop at a charming beach on the Tapajós River. Everyone is invited to take the first of many sweet and refreshing dips in the Amazon of Pará.

In the afternoon, we will continue navigating the green waters of the Tapajós River to the Jamaragua Community.

At the end of the day, as the sun sets, we will go out in small canoes to appreciate the sunset in the forest - a spectacle of the sounds of the forest and the light of the stars.



DAY 2

THE GIANT SAMAÚMA TREES IN THE TAPAJÓS NATIONAL FOREST AND THE INDIGENOUS CELEBRATION

We begin our day in the area of the Tapajós National Forest (known as FLONA), an important conservation unit spanning more than 500,000 hectares. We dock in front of the Jamaraquá community, and within this untouched nature, if the group is willing, we will take a long trail through primary forest to reach the famous giant Samaúma tree and quench the adventurous spirit at one of the most beautiful igarapés (forest streams) in the Amazon.

Considered the grandmother of the forest — believed to be around 600 years old, according to expert estimates — this Amazon giant is extraordinarily generous. Its long branches and dense canopy are capable of cradling and sheltering countless species of flora, birds, and other animals. The trail can be shortened according to the group's preference.

After paying our respects to this sovereign forest, at the end of the day we will sail to a special encounter on one of the region's beaches, where our hosts await us for a celebration ritual conducted by the Native Pajé (shaman) of the Tupinambá people — an opportunity to learn a little about the indigenous culture and traditional knowledge of the region.

Surrounded by nature, with a bonfire, prayers, and songs, we will experience the tauari smoke ritual, along with a fragrant herbal bath using Amazonian plants to revitalize body and soul.



DAY 3

THE EXPERIENCE OF NAVIGATING THE COLORFUL WATERS OF THE AMAZON

From the green waters of the Tapajós River, we will navigate towards the white waters of the Jari Channel, already within the ecosystem of the famous Amazon River. Because it is a river with more nutrients, we can hear and observe the diversity of bird species and other animals. Prepare your camera. Dolphins may appear to accompany our journey. The change in water color also accompanies the transition of fauna and flora, presenting, throughout the trip, the rich repertoire of this exuberant nature.

After toasting the sunset on the waters of the Amazon with local fruit drinks, we will continue, following the stars, to the black waters of the Arapiuns River.

The flavors of delicious Pará cuisine will be enjoyed on board, in appetizers and typical dishes at meals, prepared by our crew.



DAY 4

TWO COMMUNITIES, COUNTLESS STORIES: THE ANCIENT TRADITION OF FLOUR PRODUCTION AND THE HEALING POWER OF THE FOREST

Awakening each day in one of the precious pearls of the Amazon. This is one of the charms of our journey.

Today we will enrich your Amazonian repertoire by visiting, right after breakfast, a typical flour house where we are invited by the São Marcos community to follow the production process of cassava derivatives - essential foods for the forest peoples.

In the afternoon, we will dock at a small white sand beach, in front of the Atodi Village. Just like the chief and the shaman, it is the women who assume leadership in this community and will guide us on a walk, telling stories and sharing their knowledge.

Today's topic is forest medicine, with a demonstration of how plants and tree bark are used in the preparation of medicines.

At the end of the day, enjoy the sunset on the boat's deck.
To the sound of the best music from Pará, a special dinner awaits us to celebrate the arrival of night.



DAY 5

COROCA COMMUNITY: THE RECOVERY OF THE TURTLE SPECIES AND ORIGINAL CRAFTS

Today we meet with the Coroca community, another important village in the region. We visit the turtle lagoon and the turtle hatchery of the species recovery project, and take a break at the beautiful shop of original, high-quality handicrafts produced by the community.

We experience a true lesson on the importance of sustainable tourism for the preservation of fauna, flora, and for all the people who depend on the life of the forest.

We will also learn about natural dyeing with leaves and seeds from the forest in a special activity.

In the afternoon, we head to one of the most beautiful beaches of Arapiuns where we will rest and prepare for our farewell dinner.



DAY 6

DISEMBARKATION AMAZONIAN SUNRISE AND FAREWELL DIVE

One of the most magical moments of the trip is the Amazonian dawn, the coming of the sun creates a true festival of colors in the sky and in the reflection on the waters. We recommend getting up earlier so as not to miss this show and you can take one last farewell dive into the Tapajós River before arriving in Alter do Chão.

We will disembark on or before 12 PM, according to your flight schedule. Our team will take the group to the transfer to the Airport of Santarém, which is included in the trip.

ENCOUNTERS WITH RIVERSIDE COMMUNITIES AND INDIGENOUS VILLAGES

No one better than the people who live in the forest to show us the beauties of nature around them, the richness of their cultures, and the wisdom of the forest, passed down by the ancients and revived in each new generation. The riverside communities we will visit on the trip have from 50 to 400 inhabitants. Each day, our hosts will enrich our knowledge of the Amazon by sharing their experiences and practices: fish farming, production of cassava flour and honey, forest medicine, local cuisine, handicraft techniques, endangered species recovery projects, and hiking in their territory for us to admire wildlife.



HIKING THROUGH PRIMARY AMAZONIAN FORESTS

Feeling connected and part of the largest biodiversity reserve on the planet is to awaken awareness of the size and power of the Amazon rainforest and our place in the world. Hikes through secondary and primary forests, guided by the trained eyes of our community and village hosts, are rare opportunities to learn about the role of every living thing in this immense ecosystem and appreciate the fascinating forest universe. Hikes last from 1 to 5 hours and are tailored to the group's profile.



ANIMALS OF THE FOREST

In general, the Amazon is not the ideal destination to spot animals. But some forest characters make a point of welcoming our travelers, such as pink river dolphins, tucuxis (grey dolphins), sloths, monkeys, and numerous species of birds.



THE MOST BEAUTIFUL BEACHES IN BRAZIL ARE FRESHWATER!

When rivers are low, from July to March, beaches and sand paths are revealed, forming small freshwater paradises. We have selected the best landscapes for memorable dives during the trip.



REFRESHING IGAPÓS AND IGARAPÉS

Igapó is flooded forest during the high water season. A fantastic immersive experience that allows us to glide by in canoes and enter this ecosystem, almost reaching the treetops.

Igarapé is a creek flowing through the forest, formed by spring waters, always at a refreshing temperature. Gifts from nature to those who deserve to recharge their bodies from the hike and feast their eyes with a magical scenery hidden deep in the forest.



CULINARY DELIGHTS OF PARÁ

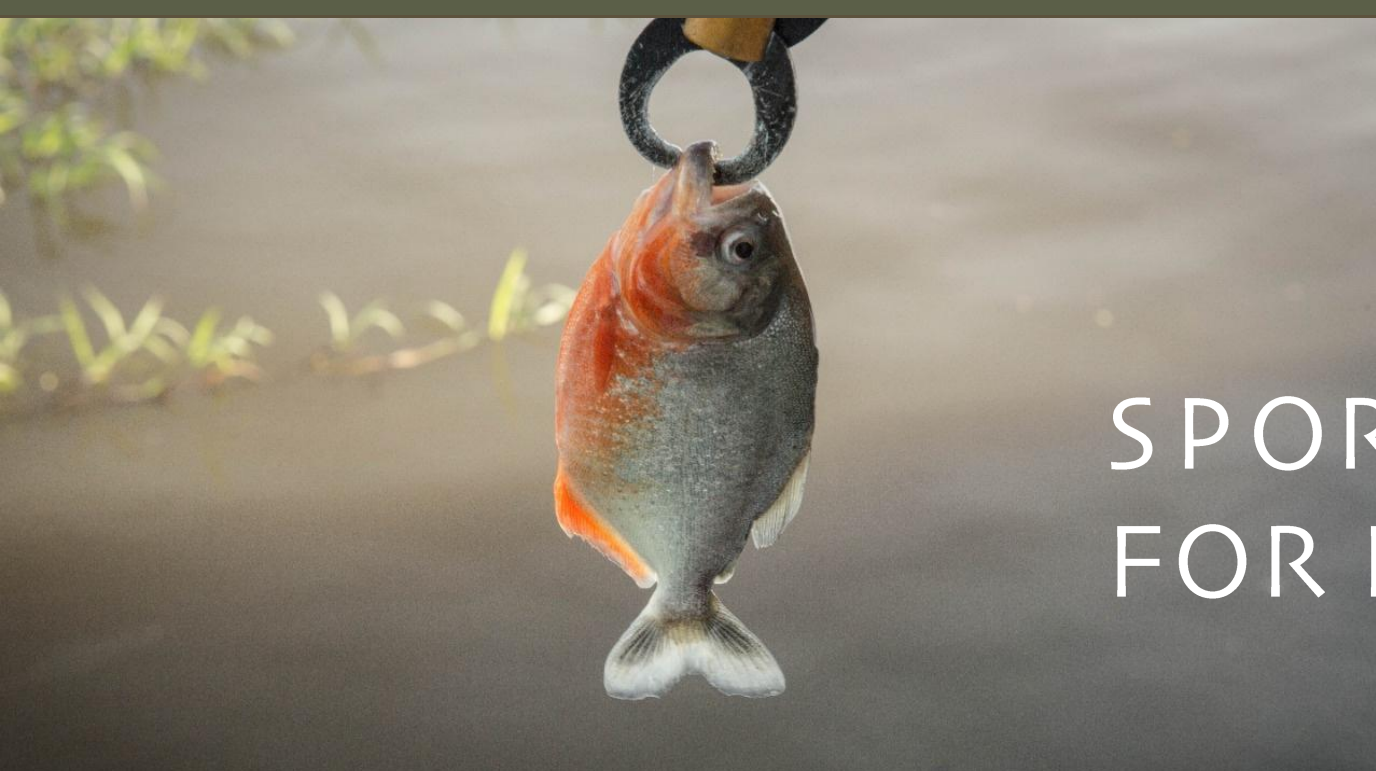
The dining experience during our trip is off the charts. Amazonian flavors can be tasted throughout the day, from delicacies at breakfast on board, appetizers served on the beach, to a variety of fish and regional recipes prepared for lunch, special dinners, and the famous *piracaia* (barbecue). The local fruits used in drinks or as an ice cream will conquer your taste buds. If you have any dietary restrictions or preferences, we can make adjustments to the menu.



HIGH-QUALITY, ORIGINAL CRAFTS

You will learn a popular technique in this region for making handicrafts of straw from the tucumã palm tree, native to the Amazon. Artisans create a wide variety of pieces through the dyeing process. Impossible to resist such a special souvenir.

Wood carvings in the shapes of local animals, bead necklaces, and earrings can also find space in your luggage.



SPORT FISHING FOR PIRANHAS

For those interested in sport fishing, we can include it in the itinerary, in areas where fishing for piranhas is permitted. A condition for this activity is to release the fish as soon as possible :)

Travelers of all ages who enjoy contact with nature and have the desire to delve deeper into the Amazon with great comfort and safety.

Our itinerary is designed to provide the best activities in this region of the Amazon interspersed with moments of relaxation. But because it is an exclusive trip, the timing and number of experiences on the itinerary are adapted to the specific profile of each group.

In this 6-day itinerary, for those who want a more relaxing trip with more beach time, we offer the option of replacing one day of activities (at the beginning or end of the trip) with an entire day on one of the beautiful beaches on the Arapiuns or Tapajós River. We will contact you two weeks before your trip to tailor your itinerary.

WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO ENJOY THIS TRIP?

Anytime! Have you ever heard that you never step in the same river twice? The waters of the Amazon are constantly changing the landscapes, making your experience unique.

In the dry season (July to December), the beaches steal our gaze.

In the flood season, it is possible to canoe through the flooded forest and reach the treetops, an experience far beyond the ordinary.

The temperature is warm all year round, and a constant pleasant breeze blows while navigating.

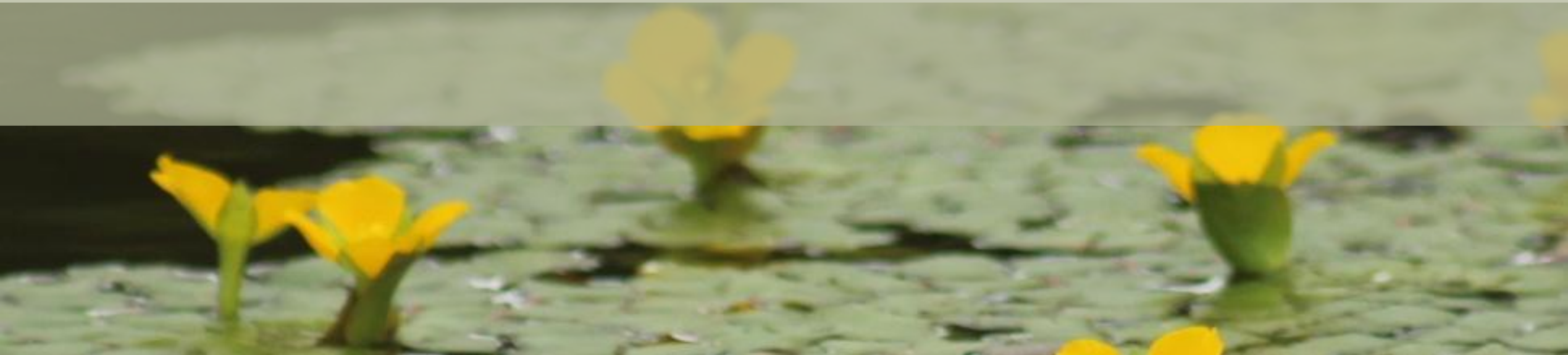
The rainy season is in the first half of the year. Rains are usually heavy but short-lived and do not disturb our trip. The second half of the year is the dry season, when rains are less frequent.

We always travel with support motorboats and safety and communication devices.

WHAT IS ON US:

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED:

Optional tips for crew and activity guides.

PAYMENT METHOD:

In installments by bank transfer: 50% deposit + 50% due up to 30 days before departure or 60 days for bookings for the period from Dec. 20 to Jan. 10.

The booking is not confirmed until the deposit is received.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Cancellation up to 90 days before the departure date: a 10% charge over the total trip cost will be levied

Cancellation from 89 to 46 days before the departure date: 30% of the total trip cost will be retained.

Cancellation from 45 to 22 days before departure: 50% of the total trip cost will be retained.

Cancellation 21 days or less before departure: an 80% of the total trip cost will be retained..

For all bookings for the period from December 20 to January 10 and for Carnival week, the cancellation fee will be 100% of the amount paid.
